

(From which Human Remains were removed.)

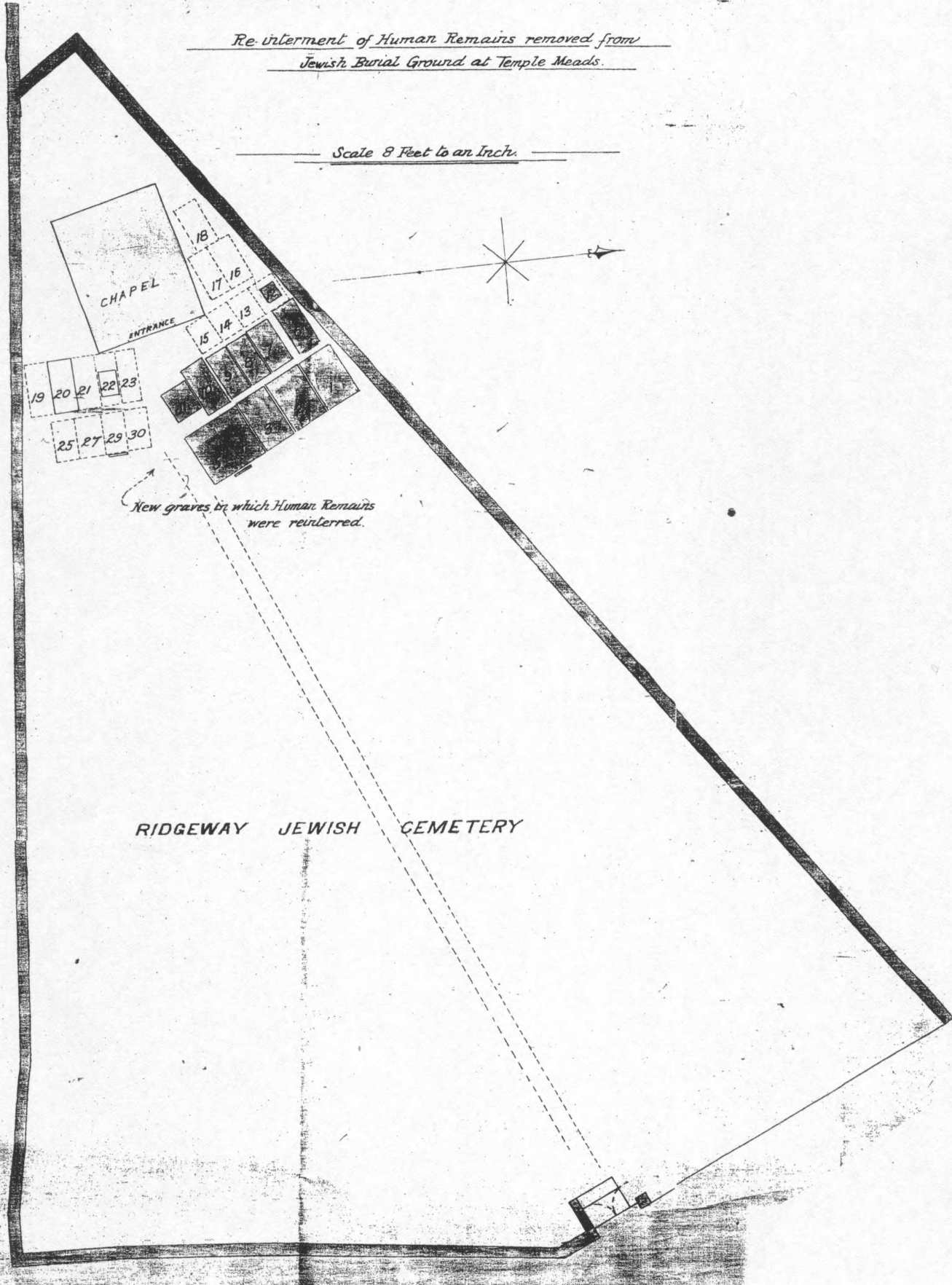
